NB: School Sport Australia age eligibility for primary school aged championships is 12 years and under in the year of competition and a minimum of 10 years of age in the year of competition. At the first trial a parent / caregiver MUST check in, sign the consent and pay a \$5.00 trial fee.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection panel will consist of the coach and at least 2 other selectors.

All girls will be given as close as possible equal time to demonstrate their skills.

Selection will be made with consideration of the following:

1. Skills demonstrated at selection trials (Footwork; Ball skills; Use of Court space)
2. Suitability for a particular court area. (i.e. defence / centre / goals)
3. Ability to respond to instructions and alter play when necessary.
4. Ability and co-operation demonstrated in playing a variety of positions.
5. Being a 'good sport' and demonstrating good behaviour on and off the field.
6. Parental permission has been obtained for the championship.

FURTHER COMPULSORY COMMITMENTS IF SELECTED

All selected team members will be required to attend:

- All Sunday team trainings from 3rd July through to 21st August (except 17th July): Including Murray Bridge Junior Lightning Netball Carnival 7th August. All trainings 1pm – 3pm Walford Anglican School Gymnasium
- A team photo shoot at a training session.

ENDORSEMENT:

Please note that selection in a SAPSASA team requires endorsement from your child's school before becoming final. Therefore you are advised not to make any arrangements that incur costs until the school has confirmed that the student fulfills all requirements.

CHAMPIONSHIP COST

An individual itemised account will be provided for every student selected in an interstate team. Championship levies, travel and training costs relevant to the student will be included on the invoice. Please note that trips interstate may be quite expensive and many have exceeded \$1000. NB: Uniforms*, accommodation, food and personal spending money will be additional costs for families and will not appear on the invoice. *All uniforms are to be ordered on-line with credit card payment direct to the supplier required to process the order.

ACCOMMODATION

Parents who are in a position to accompany their children must provide their own accommodation whilst at the championship. This also includes transport to and from the venue each day. Should this not be possible then the family will need to negotiate with SAPSASA to arrange appropriate accommodation.

TRAVEL:

If selected in a state team, a non-refundable flight booking fee applies. This amount will be included on the student's itemized account. Students have 2 travel options.

1. Travel with officials as a group to and from the championship, with all travel arrangements coordinated through the SAPSASA office.
2. Parent / Caregiver may negotiate independent travel arrangements (eg plane, bus, train car) for the return trip only. Students who are returning independently of the group, but on the same flight, bus, train, car must still be accompanied by a parent / caregiver. Team officials will not be responsible for duty of care, as seating with the team cannot be assured.
